The Breast Cancer Family Clinic accepts referrals for women aged **30 to 49** who meet the Cancer Australia high risk category criteria:

Two 1 degree or 2 degree relatives on one side of the family diagnosed with breast or ovarian cancer **plus** one or more of the following features on the same side of the family:

- additional relative(s) with breast or ovarian cancer
- breast cancer diagnosed before the age of 40
- bilateral breast cancer

- Jewish ancestry
- breast cancer in a male relative

Member of a family in which the presence of a high risk breast cancer gene mutation has been established. Women who are at potentially high risk of ovarian cancer.
